## When should someone go to the UMHCC?

People in Adelaide seeking urgent mental health support can arrive at the UMHCC at 215 Grenfell Street 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including weekends and public holidays.

SA Ambulance, SA Police and Mental Health Triage can refer directly on 08 8448 9100.

## Eligibility

To be eligible for this service, you need to be:

aged over 16

- experiencing a mental health crisis
- willing to attend the UMHCC\*
  - \* Sections 56/57 but who choose the UMHCC for assessment and are likely to stay.

## **Exclusion** criteria

- People under an Involuntary Treatment Order
- People administered intramuscular medication in the management of acute symptoms prior to arrival at the UMHCC
- People aged 16-17 years under a section 56/57


